Susan Harwood Grant Awarded to:

GateWay Community College, Phoenix, Az. The College will work with the Southwest Safety Training Alliance (SSTA) to provide 16-hour standardized safety and health training, initially to member companies and workers. The program will be upgraded, translated into Spanish, and will include an instructor's guide, course outlines, and Power Point presentations. Trainers will be trained on the new materials. Ten new member companies will be added in Southwestern United States. (Taken from www.OSHA.gov)

The SSTA staff has been working closely with Lisa Young, Program Director of Occupational Safety and Health Technology, at GateWay Community College to develop this material. Since the grant has been awarded in October 2002, we have updated our instructors manual and are in the process of translating our material into Spanish. We are working on the power point presentations in both English and Spanish.

Once the material has been reviewed by OSHA, all of the current SSTA instructors will be required to attend meetings to receive the updated instructor manual.

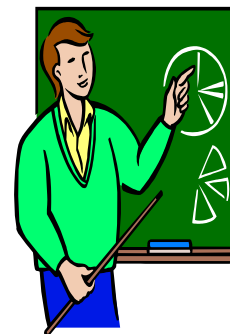
