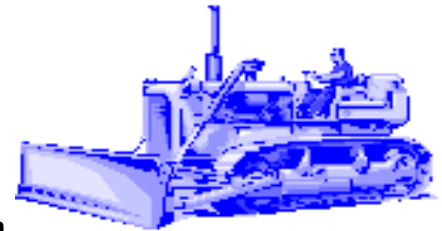

The SSTA Reality

In 1997 the founders of the SSTA made the decision to provide the valley with a safety trained construction work force. They estimated between 15,000 and 25,000 construction workers in this area needed this SSTA training.

The idea of reaching out to other parts of the Southwest was also one of their goals. For this to happen the SSTA had show it was successful here in the Phoenix area.

Most of this training has been done in Phoenix, Flagstaff, Tucson, Prescott and Albuquerque, New Mexico. Several travelers from throughout the US working in the area have also received SSTA training.



Our records show that more than 18,000 workers have completed 16-hours of SSTA safety training in the last three years. This represents more than 275,000 hours of safety training provided to the construction industry throughout the southwest. Numbers like this were unheard of just a few years ago.

The SSTA strives to reach the construction work force no matter what project, facilities, town, city or school district where the work is being done.

Organizations requiring SSTA training of their contractors are safer and better places to work.
